

BIBLIOGRAPHY ON CADANG-CADANG DISEASE OF COCONUT (*Cocos nucifera* Linn.)

Cadang-cadang is the major disease of coconut in the Philippine Islands. Its first symptom is yellowing of the older leaves due to the appearance of yellowish, irregularly shaped sopts. The affected trees then progressively wither. Various hypotheses have been put forward on the causative agent of the malady, but none has been accepted definitely. One of the most interesting aspects is the viral particles, but no transmission trial has as yet had any real success. The latest theory claims that the disease is caused by a viroid, or R.N.A. particle of low molecular weight; specific association of these particles with the disease has in fact been observed, and can constitute the basis of a method of diagnosis.
